As I sit in my bright and airy office in our expansion drafting this year's Mother's Day message, I hear a group of ladies laughing around the table in our new kitchen.

Volunteers are chatting in the adjacent conference room. I hear the giggles of children playing just outside my door. One child shyly

peeks in my office window every now and then. And one brave little friend pops in and asks me to play, sing and dance to "Baby Shark" *just one more time*.

Such welcome sounds and blessed disruptions!

In between the bursts of sound and activity, I think of Jessica*, who came to us from living in a motel with her daughter. Jessica was caught in a situation where she had been paying a daily rate that added up to almost double market rent because her income wasn't stable enough to rent an apartment. A near-tragedy brought her to us – but now that she is in our home, she is working toward obtaining safe and affordable housing.

And then there's Veronica*. She and her young son were evicted by their family. Hers is a sad and complicated story, but it's also not an isolated incident. Veronica told me that when they came to Mustard Seed, her son recognized right away that it was a home, one filled with love and laughter, where different families live together for a little while. Each day, he's SO excited to see what's on the menu.

These moms and their children have dreams for their lives. And because of people like you, we are able to provide a safe and stable environment where they can take a breath, develop a plan and begin the work of putting the pieces together so they can follow their dreams. In our home, they find warmth and welcome, guidance and love.
